-) SOUND SYSTEM and technician -see stage plot (Sound system required unless previously discussed during booking process)

- 1x Shure beta 52A kick drum mic
- 3x Shure PG56 snare/tom mics,
- 2x Shure PG81 condensor mics (overheads)
- 2x Shure 57's
- 3x Shure Beta 58's
- 3 direct boxes
- Mic Cables
- Speaker Cables
- Projector & Screen

-)      **TOUR PERSONNEL**

Our tour personnel consist of (5) people

-)      **PARKING**

The band will need adequate parking for a *15-passenger van & trailer*.

-)      **LOADERS & STAGE CREW**

We need two (2) strong volunteers to help with load in & load out. It is important to have these volunteers at the venue on time to insure a great event.

-)      **LODGING**

**2 Hotel rooms** within 15 miles of venue (Please pre-pay & have room keys available at load-in). Please request late check out.

## Host Home

**VERY IMPORTANT:** HOST HOMES/HOTELS MUST BE WITHIN 15 MILES OF VENUE. IN ADDITION, THE BAND/CREW MUST BE HOUSED AT THE SAME HOUSE (DO NOT SPLIT UP MEMBERS BETWEEN FAMILIES). *For integrity reasons, please refrain from homes with only females. \*Due to allergies, please refrain from host homes with cats or dogs. There are 3 guys + 1 married couple (Jeremy and his wife). Thank you.*

-)      **STAGING**

An 8' X 8' carpeted drum riser is preferred. This riser should be at least 12" tall. The tour does not provide ANY staging.

-)      **OPENING ACTS**

Please notify *Jeremy Willet* of ANY opening act(s). You will need express permission for the use of the tour's backline equipment (drums, amps, monitor mixes, etc.).

-)      **MERCHANDISE/VOLUNTEER**

Purchaser will provide area for merchandise and (2) 8' table. Please provide (2) people to work our merchandise table so we can concentrate on our ministry.

-)        **BIBLE STUDY ROOM**

Please provide a room for the band to change clothes, make phone calls and rest in. This room will also be used for bible study prior to the event. Please include water and food in this room prior to event.

-)        **WATER**

**WATER:** (1) case of water (24 pack) at room temperature on stage during performance.

-)        **TAXES**

Purchaser shall pay and hold artists harmless for any and all taxes, fees, dues, and the like relating to the engagement here under and the sums payable to artist shall be free of such taxes, fees, dues, and the like. Willet is a ministry of *Quest Community Church*, 501C3 status.

-)        **SETTLEMENT**

All payments on behalf of artist can be made via cash, check, cashier's check or money order. Please take care of this ahead of time. Cashiers' checks & money orders should be made payable to **\_WILLET\_**. Payment must also be made the day of performance.

-)        **CATERING**

*\*If there is a homeless shelter/soup kitchen within 10 miles of the venue, the band would like to share a meal with your neighbors prior to the concert. Please contact the shelter to find out times and make a donation to the shelter with the money you would have used to purchase food for the band. Time may not allow for this to happen at every show, so please contact [booking@willetonline.com](mailto:booking@willetonline.com) in advance to confirm Willet's availability for this.\* Finally, Willet has a "no-fast-food" policy for health and fair-trade/fair wage reasons. Thank you for respecting that.*

There are no food allergies. Below is a list of appropriate items:

- Peanut butter and jelly -Gatorade, Juice, bottled water

### **Ministry Presentation: Food for the Hungry Rider – Willet**

WILLET and FH have partnered together to assist churches and communities in doing physical and spiritual outreach. The following is a requirement for this presentation:

#### **1. Stage Appeal:**

- a. WILLET will share about Food for the Hungry and show a brief video presentation.
- b. After the appeal, there will be a 15-minute response time where attendees can become a child sponsor, make a general donation, or receive more information about the ministry.

#### **2. Booth Display:**

- a. WILLET agrees that the Food for the Hungry booth and banners will be in close proximity to the WILLET product table in a highly visible area.

#### **3. Volunteers:**

- a. The promoter must provide volunteers to pass out ministry information and child sponsorship packets during the audience response time (they will not miss out on any of the show).
- b. The volunteers must be 16 years of age or older, and be mature and responsible.
- c. WILLET will train the volunteers prior to doors opening.
- d. Instruct the volunteers to meet at the Food for the Hungry booth for training 1 hour prior to doors opening.
